#### **Procedure**

## Activity Day 1:

- Review locating theme in a reading passage.
- 2. Discuss how themes help to develop stories.
- 3. Introduce "The Scholarship Jacket" by Marta Salinas.
- 4. Require students to read the text and jot down themes that are introduced in the story as they read.
- 5. Group students in groups of 3 or 4 and have them discuss the themes that are found in the story.
- 6. Have each group report out their findings to the class.

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
